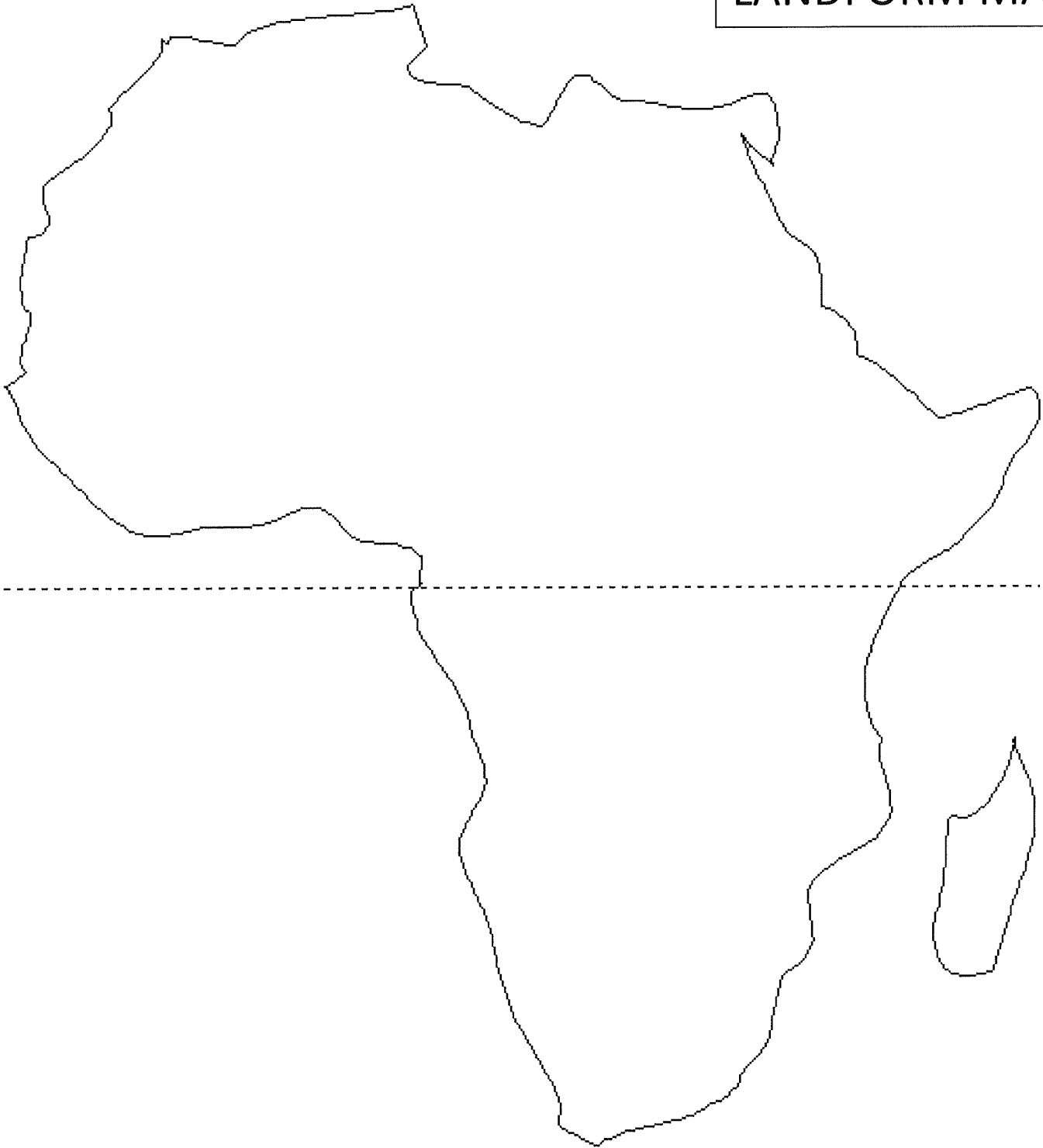

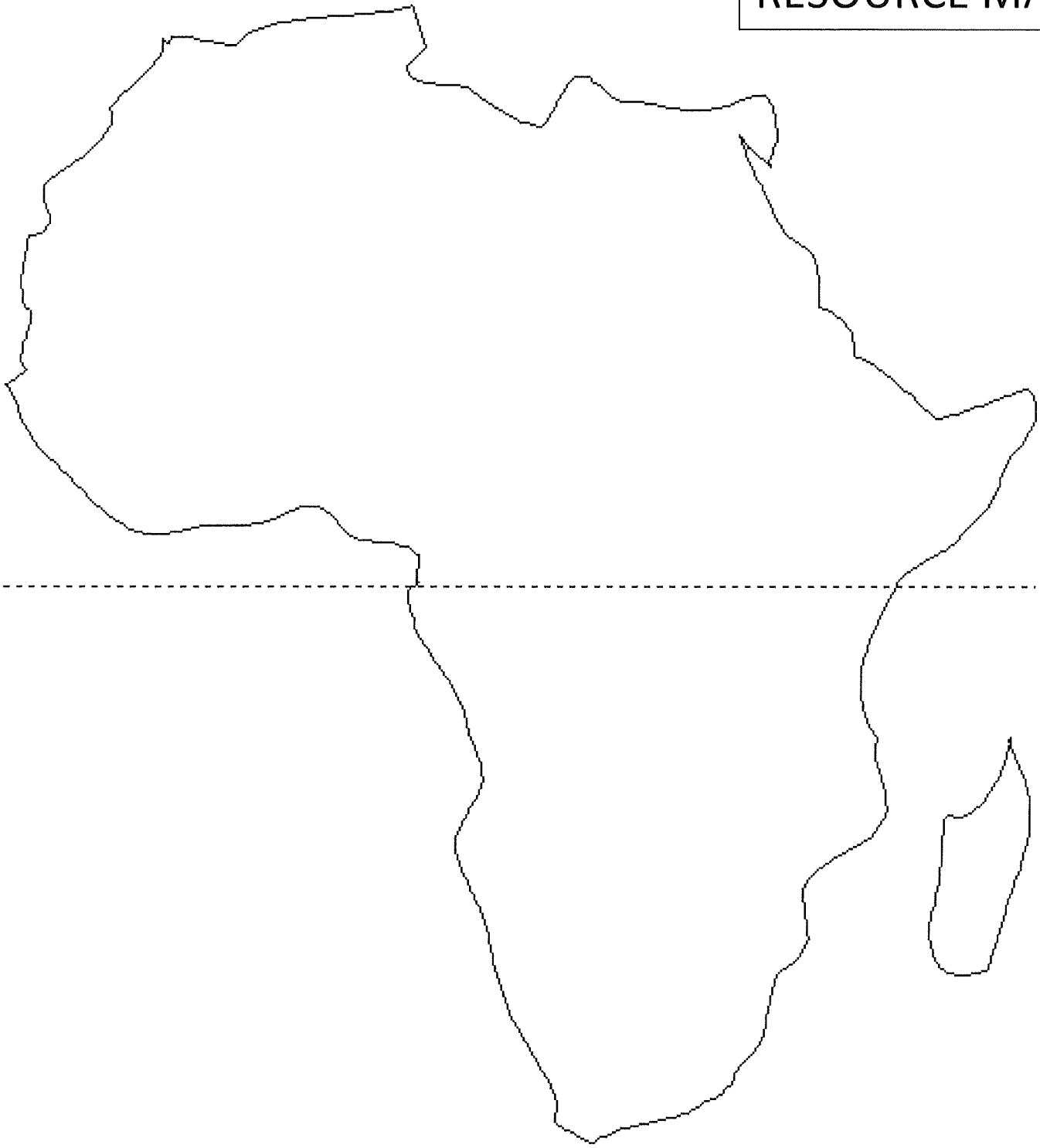
# LANDFORM MAP
